Piano (PF): Starts with a 7-measure rest, then plays a melodic line with accents and dynamics (p, mf). Includes a Flageolet on string section.

Horn (Hn): Starts with a 5-measure rest, then plays a melodic line with accents and dynamics (p, mp).

Trumpet (Trb.): Starts with a 5-measure rest, then plays a melodic line with accents and dynamics (p, mp).

Trombone (Tb.): Starts with a 5-measure rest, then plays a melodic line with accents and dynamics (p, mp).

Vibraphone (Vib.): Starts with a 5-measure rest, then plays a melodic line with accents and dynamics (p, mp).

Dynamic markings include *pizz*, *mf*, *p*, *mp*, *pp*, *al pont.*, *Flageolet on string*, *con sord*, and *(simile)*.
